

**RERC-ACT R6 Project:
Technology to Promote Decision-Making Skills and Self-Determination for
Students with Cognitive Disabilities**

Effective transition services are well-recognized as an important factor in achieving successful adult outcomes, like community inclusion and employment, for individuals with cognitive and developmental disabilities. If innovative technologies and approaches are to result in similar improved outcomes, they will have to be incorporated into best practice in transition and transition services. This is a large-scale, randomized study that will investigate the impact of cognitively accessible technology (Decision Manager and JobQuest - AbleLink Technologies) on the ability of students with cognitive disabilities to make independent decisions about the transition areas of independent living, community inclusion, recreation and leisure, and employment.
