The Colorado Assistive Technology Coalition

The major goal of the AT Act is to improve access to and acquisition of AT devices and services for individuals in education, employment, community living, information technology, and telecommunications. The goals will be met through the development of an online device exchange program, identifying alternative financing programs, and conducting device demonstration events throughout the State. Additionally, through coordination and collaboration with other State agencies and organizations, assistive technology awareness training, training on the use of technology, and ongoing technical assistance is provided. The Colorado Assistive Technology Coalition comprised of AT users and State leaders of organizations that implement training on AT serves as the advisory committee overseeing the implementation of the AT Act.
